



If a garment is labelled OCS 100, that means it's 100% organic cotton, whereas OCS blended means there's something else in the mix, like rPET.

Oeko-Tex® ensures that all our garments have been tested for any nasty chemicals that nobody wants in their clothes. We hold the highest level of classification, class 1.



Making sure our rPET is the real deal

We use recycled polyester in some of our garments, and RCS makes sure that any recycled material we use is definitely recycled!
